³ "Graduates" is the number of students who completed the program within 100% of the published program length.

⁴ "Completion Rate" is the number of Graduates divided by the Number of Students Available for Graduation.

III. PLACEMENT RATE

The degree programs are unique in that upon completion, international student graduates either continue their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution degree or resume pastoral or missionary duties in their home country.
